The Organizer (see below) will not accept any conditions contradictory to or deviating from these general terms and conditions.

Registration

Registration for the symposium must be done by registration via e-mail. Participants will receive confirmation of registration details and details of bank transfer.

If you do not receive a receipt or a ticket, please send an email to peter@prosimspinkej.cz to ensure that the organizer has received the registration form. Registration will only be effective upon receipt of a registration fee payment. Please inform the organizer of any corrections to your registration. Order entry agrees with these terms and conditions as well as the privacy policy and terms of use of the site.

Fees and Payment Conditions

We only accept payment via invoice when registering for the symposium. After the payment, the Participant will receive an e-mail message with details on the financial transaction. All payments are made in Czech crown (CZK) or EURO (€) currency.

The early bird registration fee is 1 990,- CZK/€ 80 for a regular participant. The fee includes admission to whole day symposium. Early-bird registration ends on 31 August 2019.

Thereafter, the registration fee is 2 490,- CZK/€ 100 for regular participants.

All bank fees and money transfer costs must be paid by the transmitter. As a variable symbol enter the number of the advance invoice and in the note the full name of the participant.

Travel, accommodation, food, insurance and all other expenses are excluded from registration fees and are not covered by the symposium organizers. The pro forma invoice you receive after registration has to be paid in 30 days.

Only fully completed registration forms will be accepted. An invoice will be sent after the receipt of your registration, a confirmation of payment will be sent upon receipt of payment in full. If the payment is not made before the deadline expires, the registration will remain valid, but the fee will increase to full price after the pre-sale price ends.

The symposium organisers can not guarantee that a symposium bag and other symposium materials will be available for late registrations.

Cancellation

The Organizer do not reimbursed registration fee. We will not refund the money if you cancel your contract. The Participant has the right to appoint a substitute at any time without additional cost. All changes must be submitted in written form – with the indication of full name, registration details, invoice number, – to the Organizer via peter@prosimspinkej.cz

The Organizer reserves the right to modify the content of the program, the speakers and the times of presentations. If the number of participants is insufficient, the Organizer reserves the right to cancel the Symposium and all related products and/or services without any liability on his part. In the case of a cancellation by the Organizer participants will be reimbursed the registration fee actually paid.

Liability

The Organizer does not accept liability for the up-to-dateness, correctness, and completeness with respect to symposium documentation and content, including the Symposium website. The liability of the Organizer - regardless of the legal cause - is limited to cases of gross egligence and willful misconduct.

Photographs, videos, etc.

The Organizer may free of charge and without the further consent of the participants make, use and release pictures, videos and shots during the Symposium for reports of the Symposium and announcement of events in future.

Privacy Policy

All personal data provided to the Organizer for registration will be treated as confidential and accordingly to the EU legislation - GDPR. The data shall be used and stored for further processing and documentation purposes. The information will not be re-used for an incompatible purpose. Data shall be delivered to assigned service providers, as deemed necessary for the successful performance of the Symposium.

Severability Clause

If any provision of these Terms and Conditions is found to be invalid, the invalidity of that provision will not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of these Terms and Conditions, which shall remain in full force and effect.

Disputes

All agreements between the Organizer and the Participants and all disputes which may arise between the Organizer and the Participants shall be exclusively subject to Czech law. Court of jurisdiction shall be Prague, if not otherwise required by the Czech Consumer Protection Act.

Abstracts

The Organizer does not carry any liability and is not responsible for correctness or incorrectness of abstracts (texts, figures, etc.) provided by Participants. By submission of an abstract, the Participants are claiming that they have received consent from their co-authors and affiliated institutions to do so; this holds also for any further presentation of their original work in the form of a poster or oral presentation at the Symposium. Participants are responsible to conform intellectual property rights (IPR) and do not infringe IPR of third parties.

Publication of Abstracts

The Organizer may free of charge and without the further consent of the participants publish the abstracts that are accepted for oral or poster presentation at the Symposium (symposium website, abstract booklet, etc.). The participant ensures that the submitted abstract (text, figures, further content) conforms to the intellectual property rights (IPR) and does not infringe IPR of third parties. The symposium organizer is not responsible for any IPR issue regarding the publication of abstracts at the symposium webpage and in printed form whatsoever. Use of exhibition and designated symposium areas The symposium will take place in promises described above. The Organizer expressly forbid following all over the building and other designated areas:

- to smoke, pursuant to the current legislation;
- to post, by means of adhesive tape, nails, glue or other means, any advertising notices, posters, bills or other materials on the walls, pillars, and inside and outside the windows; such materials may only be posted on dedicated poster-holders and wall panels by means of easily-removable paper adhesive tape;

GDPR

Information on personal data processing during purchase of tickets.

Processes the following personal data of its customers:

- your comment and evaluation in compliance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and

on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (hereinafter referred to as the “ Regulation ”) for the purpose of performing the contract and keeping record of the contract and/or for potential future exercise and defense of the rights and obligations of the contracting parties. The personal data shall be stored and processed for the above-stated purpose for a period of 10 years from the performance of the last part under the contract, unless another legal regulation requires a longer period for the storage of contractual documentation.

The above-mentioned processing is possible on the basis of:

- Article 6 (1) (b) of the Regulation – processing is necessary for the performance of a contract, and
- Article 6 (1) (f) of the Regulation – processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the controller.

The Organizer hereby declares that all personal data are confidential and shall not be provided to any third party. An exception applies to providers of payment gateways, who are provided with the personal data of costumers to the minimum extent necessary to enable the payment of orders, as well as to the following processors:

- a. Webhosting provider Websupport.;
- b. Provider of software designed for e-mail communication MailChimp;
- c. Potential further providers of processing software, services and applications, which the company is not using at present.

The Organizer shall send commercial communications to your e-mail address, since such procedure is allowed under Section 7 (3) of Act No. 480/2004 Coll., on Information Society Services, unless you reject them. Such communications may only concern similar goods or services and you may unsubscribe from them easily any time - by sending a letter or e-mail or by clicking the unsubscribe link in the commercial communication. The Organizer shall store your e-mail address for this purpose for a period of 5 years from the contracting parties' entering into the last contract.

Under the Regulation, as a customer you have the right:

- to request that we inform you which of your personal data we process,
- to request access to such data and to have these data updated or corrected or to request a restriction of their processing,
- to request that we erase these personal data, unless such request concerns personal data that we are obliged or entitled to process under the applicable legislation,
- to data portability, and the right to request a copy of the personal data being processed,
- to obtain effective judicial redress if you believe that your rights under the Regulation have been infringed as a result of the processing of your personal data at variance with the Regulation,
- to bring the matter before the Company or the Office for Personal Data Protection if you have doubts about the compliance with the duties connected with personal data processing.

Information regarding taking photographs
